Professor Epaminondas Tsianos is the new president of the Hellenic Society of Gastroenterology.

He was born in Trikala in 1948 and graduated from the Medical School of the University of Athens in 1972. He was then trained in Internal Medicine in the 2nd Propaedeutic Department of Internal Medicine under the thoughtful instruction of Prof. G. Gardikas. In 1978 he was board certified as a specialist in Internal Medicine and during the same year he was awarded a Ph. D. degree with an excellent for a thesis on "Intravascular Coagulation in Diabetes Messitus assessed by plasma Fibrinogen Chromatography". Afterwards he started his training in Gastroenterology in December 1978, initially at Evangelismos General Hospital in Athens, under the supervision of

U.S.A. from September 1988 to September 1989.
